

MEMBERSHIP CODE OF CONDUCT

All members and visitors to the Community Center are expected to follow these conduct standards:

- Act in a mature and responsible manner at all times.
- Show respect towards the requests and instructions of Community Center staff, instructors, coaches, and leadership while they are performing their duties.
- Adhere to any rules and guidelines established for the specific program, event, or class.

As a patron of this facility, it is important to refrain from the following behaviors:

- Aggressive behavior of any kind, including physical abuse, verbal abuse, threats, intimidation, harassment, bullying, and/or any conduct that threatens or endangers the safety of any person.
- Rude or argumentative behavior towards staff, officials, instructors, or other patrons.
- Disrupting or obstructing any program, event, or class.
- Lewd, obscene, or indecent conduct or expression, including profanity, or offensive remarks.
- Any use or solicitation of illegal drugs or alcohol.
- Willful damage or destruction to the facility or property.
- Sharing membership cards for access to the facility or access to programs, services, or classes.
- Unauthorized entry to areas such as staff offices, equipment, or storage rooms.
- Unauthorized use of facility computers or audio-visual equipment.
- Photography and video taping of participants or visitors without prior approval of participants or an authorized staff member.
- Unauthorized commercial activity – no person is allowed to post, advertise, instruct in private lessons, or solicit individuals in the facility for personal services or for personal businesses that are not directly affiliated and/or approved through the Mary C. Winder Community Center.
